Simulation Immersion II returns July 27 through July 31, bringing together our NAR2 cohort for an exciting week of advanced clinical learning, collaboration, and team building. After completing a strong first six months of clinical education, students will return to campus to further develop the knowledge and hands-on skills necessary as they transition into the next phase of clinical training this August.

This year's immersion will include:

- Point of Care Ultrasound (POCUS)
- Peripheral nerve blocks
- OB interprofessional education simulation
- Pediatric crisis resource management and airway skills
- Difficult airway management
- Neuraxial blocks
- Central line insertion
- SEE preparation
- Escape room team-building activities

Beyond simulation and procedural training, the week will focus heavily on teamwork, wellness, and cohort bonding. Evening activities and team-building events are planned throughout the week, creating opportunities for students to reconnect, recharge, and strengthen professional relationships.
